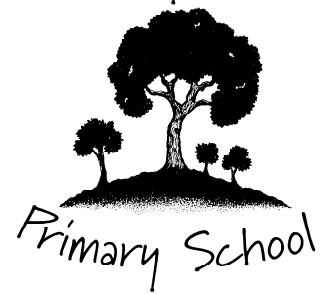

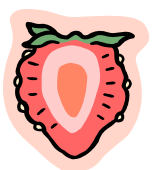

The library is in school every Tuesday, in the library, between 2.45pm and 3.45pm.



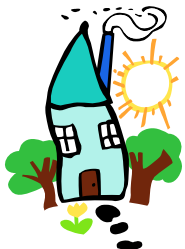
Parental Consultations and Book Fair
