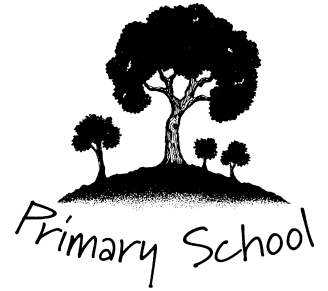

- Key Stage 2 Stars are Celeste Johnson, Joseph Cowen and Kyle Munro.

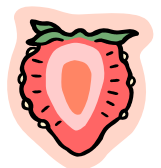

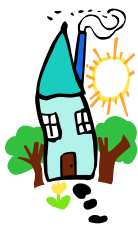
Notices
