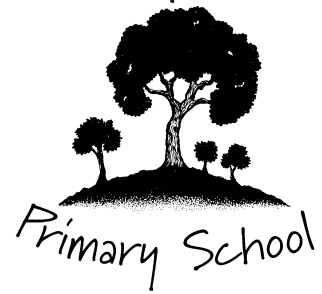

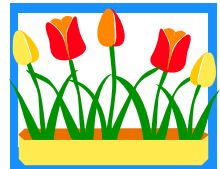

Well done to Jay Tague who won third prize, with his painting, at the Spring Bulb and Flower Show held at Whickham.

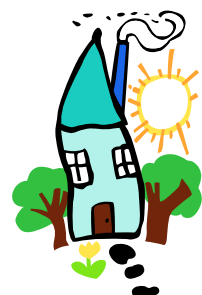
