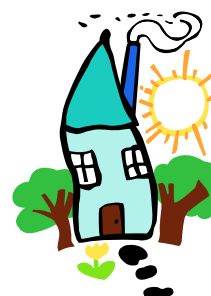

## What's Going On

During the Autumn term children in Year 6 were asked if they would take part in a government survey of children and young people. The aim is to find out how children feel about their school and the area in which they live. Thirty-six children took part in our school and their responses are recorded anonymously and compared with views of other children in Gateshead and nationally. Some of the results were very interesting.

Most of my teachers tell me how I am doing with my work:

Agree:	School	92%
	Gateshead	67%
	Nationally	63%

Most of my teachers make lessons fun and interesting:

Agree:	School	80%
	Gateshead	49%
	Nationally	46%

I get enough help at school with learning:

Agree:	School	81%

We have enough chances to learn somewhere that is not in a classroom (this can include learning outside, going on a visit):

Agree:	School	76%

My school is giving me useful skills and knowledge:

How safe do you feel where you live?

Very Safe:	School	53%

These particular questions have been chosen because they show some of the greatest difference in percentages when compared with Gateshead and national results. The children completed the survey independently.
