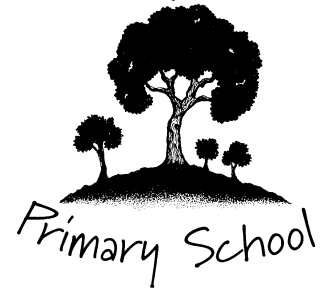

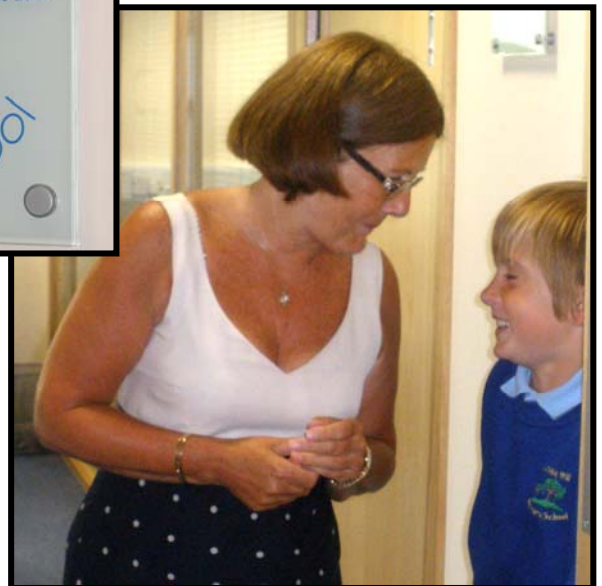


On Tuesday 29 June Mrs Howard officially opened the Howard Room.

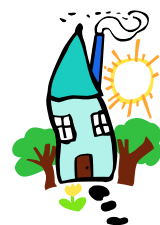
